

Covid-19 Checklist

We tick all the boxes!



- Clear procedures in place for staff to follow if there is a suspected case in the nursery
- Blanket policy for children and adults to be removed from contact with others immediately if displaying symptoms
- Families and staff to follow strict policies for self-isolation if displaying signs of coronavirus unless tested and results are negative
- Staff have thermometers in the rooms to check children's temperatures if they appear unwell
- Staff and children will wash hands on entering and leaving the building and frequently throughout the day
- Hand sanitiser will be provided for anyone entering the nursery and in all rooms
- PPE will be provided when required for personal care, laundry, cleaning and emptying bins etc
- Lots of fun activities to encourage the children in good hygiene practices
- All environments, resources, equipment to be cleaned after use
- All toilets cleaned and disinfected after every use
- No toys, resources etc to be shared by groups of children unless cleaned first
- Stringent cleaning of door handles, handrails and key codes etc throughout the day.
- Any soft toys or those hard to clean will be removed from children's use
- All toys used are cleaned daily, including outside toys
- Carpets cleaned regularly
- All laundry washed at 80 degrees
- Windows to be opened to circulate fresh air
- Fogging of settings with disinfectant completed weekly
- Nappies supplied at all settings



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- Children to be dropped off and collected at the door (with the exception of distressed children)
- Parents to maintain social distancing while dropping off/collecting
- One adult from each family to drop off/collect
- No visitors/contractors allowed in the nursery during times when the children are present only in an emergency
- Staff and children to be based in their room and no mixing with other groups
- Staff to follow procedures to limit their contact with others including not using public transport to get to and from work
- No other adults within the nursery settings
- Children only able to attend one setting, not two e.g. nursery and pre-school, for the time being
- Staff following stringent procedures for socially distancing from other adults while at work including using phones to contact other rooms or the office/kitchen
- Outdoor play will be encouraged as much as possible with hand washing facilities available
- Children will not go out on outings or visits and we will not have additional teachers in the nursery for the time being
- Malleable materials and resources such as play dough and sand used in their own trays
- No buggies, car seats, scooters etc from home allowed to be left in the nursery building
- No self service of meals for the children for the time being
- Nursery show rounds conducted on Saturdays and evenings
- Staff training on all new procedures when returning to work
